

Gallipoli: The South Australian Story
Regional Touring Program 2005 – 2008

Gallipoli: The South Australian Story ended its official two-year tour of regional areas across South Australia in November 2006. By popular demand, this tour has now been extended into 2007 and 2008.

This specially designed travelling display is based on themes and information that were presented in the History Trust's major 2005 exhibition of the same name, at the History Trust's Exhibition Gallery at the Torrens Parade Ground in Adelaide. This exhibition has closed. Both the exhibition and travelling display were produced to mark the 90th anniversary of the Gallipoli campaign of 1915.

The travelling display gives regional South Australians, particularly school students, the opportunity to learn more about South Australia's significant contribution to the Gallipoli campaign, which has, since 1915, had a profound impact on Australia's national pride and identity.

Museums within the History Trust's Museums Accreditation and Grants Program have hosted the display over the past two years. Local RSL and other ex-service organisations have also used the display as part of their group activities.

In 2007 and 2008 local museums and other organisations will be given the opportunity to host the display. Please contact the History Trust if your organisation would like to host the display.
