



How to install the exhibition



The travelling exhibition will arrive like this:

7 double-sided pull-up banners each inside a labelled canvas zip up bag

4 wooden crates protected by bubble wrap

Each crate contains an A-frame consisting of 2 framed replica medals of 2 men (1 man represented on each side)

Setting up the crates

- Unwrap bubble wrap carefully (save as much as possible for packing for return trip)
- Pull down the hinged side and slide out the shiny black lid of the crate
- Carefully pull out the hinged A-frame (it might be stiff as it fits snugly inside the crate, protected by the foam rubber inner lining) and set up according to instructions (in plastic sleeve inside the crate)

NB when replacing the black lid you may need to give the hinged section a slight thump with the side of your hand to ensure it closes tight



Each banner bag is labelled with a number and panel name so you can work out the order that they need to be displayed.

- 1. Intro Title / Where heroes are made
- 2. South Australians go to war / The story of the Victoria Cross
- 3. Blackburn / Leak Set up alongside corresponding crate with A-frame of replica medals. Ensure medals are next to right man
- 4. Jensen / Inwood Set up alongside corresponding crate with A-frame of replica medals. Ensure medals are next to right man
- 5. Davey / Weathers Set up alongside corresponding crate with A-frame of replica medals. Ensure medals are next to right man
- 6. Woods / Sullivan Set up alongside corresponding crate with A-frame of replica medals. Ensure medals are next to right man
- 7. Celebration and silence / acknowledgements

Setting up banners

To decrease risk of damage, it's a good idea to place the banners in their bags where you intend setting them up rather than moving them after they have been set up

- Take out base and folded rod (inside long pocket) from bag
- Put the rod together and place one end in the socket in centre of base on the ground
- Carefully pull up one banner and clip top end of rod into place so it is secure (you may need to tip the base towards you as you are pulling up the banner)
- Pull up the second banner on the other side and clip top end of rod into place (again it may be easier to tip the base towards you as you are pulling up banner)
- Do the same for all 7 double-sided banners

On a table or suitable surface near display, place visitors' book, open at appropriate page, with a pen to encourage comments
