Challenge your friends to see who can find the weird and wonderful things at all of our museums!

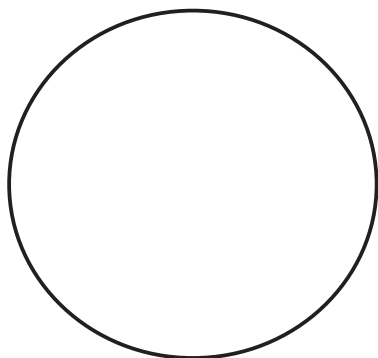
