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The History Trust's Impact program addresses key issues in Aboriginal and contact history, the dispossession of Aboriginal people and its legacy of racism. Impact is a powerful and challenging experience that examines the other side of South Australia's history and encourages participants to view historical events inclusive of Aboriginal peoples' experiences. The program is delivered as a multi-media presentation, supported by a range of sources including archival photographs, documents, Aboriginal voices and video footage.

The program's focus is on the history of the colonisation of South Australia and its continuing impact.

Impact complements and supports cultural awareness and cultural safety training programs and is designed to be one step in a learning journey.

PARTICIPANTS WILL:

- ✓ Be exposed to events, policies, language, and practices that have impacted in both an individual and cumulative manner on Aboriginal people here in South Australia
- ✓ Gain an enhanced understanding of Aboriginal Peoples' connection to country and the impact of colonisation practices on that connection
- ✓ Learn of the intergenerational nature of trauma impacting Aboriginal people, in particular the Stolen Generations
- ✓ Be provided with an opportunity to make connections between this learning and expected work outcomes

CULTURAL SAFETY WARNING

The program discusses several traumatic events regarding South Australia's history including the names of Aboriginal families and individuals impacted by the Stolen Generations, frontier violence, Exemption Certificates, and activism.



The program can be tailored to meet the learning needs of specific organisations.
